LATE WORK POLICY

Late work is greatly discouraged. However, because emergencies due occur I have developed the policy below.

- **For emergencies** (serious illness, accidents, natural disasters): Please e-mail me the information about your emergency and request approval to make up the assignment or exam. Whenever possible, documentation needs to be provided, such as with a doctor's excuse.
- For all other matters (work, technical, or other personal issues): Please contact me to see whether or not your late work may be accepted. If accepted, there will be a per diem late penalty of 5% of the assignment points per day up to four days. This does not apply to the discussion forums. Discussion forums are an interactive activity and must be completed during the week they are due.

ACADEMIC DISHONESTY

The penalty for cheating or any other form of academic dishonesty including plagiarism will be in accordance with college policy. This can range from receiving a 0 to receiving a failing grade for the course or even expulsion.
