Shatter

It is made by extracting cannabinoids from the cannabis plant.

Rosin

Rosin is made by pressing a plant's dried flower and kief in a heated press. The process is reminiscent of the process used to make violin bows. The final product is usually a waxy, translucent concentrate. The process is relatively simple and can be done at home. The best rosin comes from high-quality starting material.

Some producers use a traditional "cold cure" to produce a creamy, buttery consistency. However, the finished rosin product may be contaminated with air, which can affect the quality of the extracts.

Live Resin

Unlike shatter, wax, and oils, live resin cannabis concentrates are not cured. Instead, they are made from fresh, never dried cannabis flowers, sugar leaves, and a small number of terpenes. The resulting product is spicy, sticky, and dark yellow.

While live resin can be used on a blunt or in a dab rig, it is best consumed with a dab tool. This electronic rig is designed to hold the live resin in a dab well. A dab tool is a small device with a scoop on one end, a nail, and a torch. A dab pen is a similar device, but it is handheld and can be adjusted to control the temperature.

Terp Sauce
