

Unusual Enrollment History (UEH)

UEH must be resolved before you will receive federal financial aid.

The U.S. Department of Education has selected your file for review due to your Unusual Enrollment History (UEH). A UEH is defined by having attended multiple colleges/universities in the past three years. The U.S. Department of Education has established this UEH regulation to prevent fraud and abuse in the Federal Pell Grant Program and Direct Student Loan Program by identifying students with unusual enrollment histories.

What this means for you:

- If you received the Federal Pell Grant or Federal Direct Student Loans at multiple institutions in recent academic years (2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, and 2018-2019), your 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be flagged for unusual enrollment history (UEH).
- The reason for this flag is that unusual enrollment history MAY be an indicator that a student is enrolling just long enough to receive a credit balance (refund) of federal or state financial aid.
- If your application is flagged, the Financial Aid Office is required to review your enrollment history at each institution that you attended to determine whether or not academic credit was earned during these award years.
- If you received the Federal Pell Grant and/or Direct Student Loans, and academic credit was not earned at each institution during these award years, the Financial Aid Office will advise you that you are ineligible to receive financial aid and of your right to appeal the decision.
- Your appeal will require that you provide a signed statement explaining why you failed to earn academic credits. **You must also provide third party documentation to support this explanation.**
- **Your appeal must also include a separate statement and documentation for each of the institutions where you failed to earn credits.**
- Your appeal must also include the official transcripts from each college that you attended.
- Based on the information that you submit with your appeal, the Financial Aid Office will determine if you had a valid reason(s) for your unusual enrollment history.
- If your appeal is approved, you will be able to receive Federal Title IV aid at Talladega College.
- If your appeal is denied, you have the option of paying out-of-pocket for 6 credit hours in your program of study and re-appealing for financial aid once you have successfully earned at least a 'C' grade out of each class. Withdrawals and failures during the term without financial aid will reflect poorly on any subsequent appeal.

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Due to your unusual enrollment history, Talladega College is required to review your enrollment history and determine whether or not you are enrolling only long enough to receive cash refunds of federal student aid. **In the process of reviewing your enrollment history, Talladega College will check the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) to obtain a complete history including the name of each institution you have attended, and the dates of attendance.**
